Scripture Background: *Unity in the church is a theme dear to Paul’s heart as he writes to the church at Corinth. What is the true church supposed to be like? It is like a field, and God causes the growth. It is like a building with the foundation of Jesus Christ. And when the believers are together, the church is the new temple where God’s Spirit dwells.*

Messiah’s Partners In Ministry Goal (derived from scripture): *To live in harmony with each other in the church. Providing men and women experiences where they are working together in church activities and worship.*

Explanation: *Spiritual foundations are important. God wants us to build on our gathering together, the church, with only one foundation. God’s important metaphors teach us how to really be church family. The field metaphor stresses that no leaders in the church are more important than any other, because only God can make plants grow. The building metaphor shows us the importance of the right foundation—Christ. It also shows us that leaders have a great responsibility to build the church with the right materials—things that truly matter. The local body of believers, when they are together, is the temple of God’s Holy Spirit. We can build God’s temple by working together.*

Richard Amar Sarker

Asia-Pacific Region based in Chennai, India

Richard is called to build relationships with Lutheran churches in the Asia Pacific region, to walk with them and learn from them. As he is called to serve people in need, he works with the Church and other leaders to learn about their challenges. Together, they try to find the best way to solve those issues. They also strive to increase the capacity of the local people to become leaders in their own communities rather than looking indefinitely for outside support.

WELCA MISSION PROJECTS

Offerings given through the Mission Emphasis held in March each year continue to be earmarked for the NAVAJO EVANGELICAL LUTHERAN MISSION in Arizona.

LUTHERAN WORLD RELIEF GLOBAL MINISTRIES PROJECTS

PERSONAL CARE KITS: Include the following items in each health kit: 1 lightweight bath size towel (max. 52"X27") prefer a dark color, 2 bath-size bars (4-5 oz) of soap, any brand in original packaging, 1 adult-size toothbrush in original packaging, 1 sturdy comb, remove packaging, 1 metal nail clippers (attached file optional) remove packaging. Wrap items in the towel and tie with ribbon or yarn. (do not use plastic bags)

SCHOOL KITS: The following is required for each school kit: 4 70-sheet notebooks, 1 30-centimeter ruler, or a ruler with centimeters on one side and inches on the other, 1 pencil sharpener, 1 blunt scissors (safety scissors with embedded steel blades work well), 5 unsharpened #2 pencils with erasers; secure together with a rubber band, 5 black or blue ballpoint pens (no gel ink); secure together with a rubber band, 1 box of 16 or 25 crayons, 1 2 ½" eraser, 1 sturdy drawstring backpack-style bag approximately 14"X17" with shoulder straps (no standard backpacks). Pack items in cloth bag and close. (do not use plastic bags)

QUILTS: At least 60" x 80" (no smaller) made from new or used sturdy material. Fillers may be worn bedspreads, drapes, bathrobes, blankets, etc. Clothing can be used for tops. One top or backing needs 5 yds. of 36" wide or 4 yds. of 45" material. Messiah quilting days are January, February, and March - Monday afternoons and all day Tuesdays.

FABRIC KITS: Include the following items: 2 pieces of cotton or cotton-blend fabric (no knits or 100% polyester). Each piece should match one of the following sizes: 2 ¼ yds of 60" wide fabric OR 3 yds of 44" wide fabric OR 4 yds of 36" wide fabric and 1 spools of neutral-colored, general purpose thread, 250-300 yards each. Fold thread and 1 piece of fabric inside second fabric piece and tie with year, sturdy string, ribbon or a strip of fabric.

BABY CARE KITS: Include: 2 lightweight cotton t-shirts, 2 long or short-sleeved gowns or sleepers (without feet), 2 receiving blankets, medium-weight cotton or flannel or crocheted or knitted with lightweight year, up to 52: square, 4 cloth diapers, flat fold preferred, 1 jacket, sweater or sweatshirt with a hood or include a baby cap, 2 pairs of socks, 1 hand towel, dark color preferred, 2 bath-size bars (4-5oz) of gentle soap, in original wrapping, 2 diaper pins or large safety pins. Wrap in one receiving blanket and secure with pins.

BLANKETS: Clean, used blankets in good condition or new blankets (must be washed to avoid paying duty). Cash donations are accepted.

NEWBORN KITS: 1 – 36" square muslin or sheeting, 1 bath towel, 1 wash cloth, 1 – bath size bar white ivory soap, 1 newborn stocking cap, 1 small baby shirt, 1 receiving blanket, pack in 2 – gallon "ziploc" plastic bag. \$5.00 donation to Global Ministries.
